

Albyn School Scholarships

Albyn offers up to six scholarships each year for pupils entering Upper I. Scholarships are available for special ability in the Academic Curriculum, Art and Design, Music and Physical Education. They are worth 5% of the fees.

Scholarships are tenable throughout a pupil's time in Upper School. All scholarships are reviewed annually to monitor progress and ensure the scholar is living up to the expectations outlined in this document. Please note that in extreme cases and after warnings the school reserves the right to cancel a scholarship.

Academic Scholarship

Academic Scholarships are awarded on the basis of combined scores in English, Maths and Verbal Reasoning.

As the holder of an Academic Scholarship the pupil will be expected to:

- ▶ Act as a good role model to other pupils.
- ▶ Work hard to achieve his or her best in all subjects whilst a pupil at Albyn.

Physical Education Scholarship

Pupils invited to sit the Physical Education Scholarship test will be assessed in the following activities: **Gymnastics, Dance, Ball Skills and Racket Skills**

As the holder of the Physical Education Scholarship the pupil will be expected to:

- ▶ Act as a good role model to other pupils.
- ▶ Make a regular commitment to extra-curricular activities within school, including school teams, which can involve additional time out of school hours (such as after school and at weekends).
- ▶ Become involved with Physical Education-based activities on a regular basis whilst a pupil at the School.
- ▶ Take Physical Education as an Academic Subject up to the end of Upper V.

Music Scholarship

During the Music Scholarship assessment, candidates should perform one piece on each instrument played, including the recorder if played, and also sing one song of their choice. Candidates will be asked to perform a piece of sight-reading on their main instrument. In the case of orchestral or singing performances, piano accompaniments should be brought to the assessment.

As the holder of the Music Scholarship the pupil will be expected to:

- ▶ Act as a good role model to other pupils.
- ▶ Make a regular commitment to extra-curricular activities, involving the Music Department, (choirs, orchestras, and other groups) whilst a pupil at Albyn School.
- ▶ Take Music as an academic subject up to the end of Upper V.

Art and Design Scholarship

The Art and Design Scholarship is based on testing the candidate's ability to **observe** and **record**.

As the holder of the Art and Design Scholarship the pupil will be expected to:

- ▶ Act as a good role model to other pupils.
- ▶ Make a regular commitment to extra-curricular activities within school involving Art and Design whilst a pupil at the School.
- ▶ Take Art and Design as an academic subject up to the end of Upper V.
